Smiths Grove, KY
Oct. - 3 - 1938

Meeting called to order by Chairman Simmons.

All members present.

Minutes of last regular meeting read & approved.

Bill of Smith Grove Echo for printing approved, also Bill of H. Butram for 3 ½ tons lime dust at \$1.50 per ton approved.

Bill of J. E. Bohannon for telephone calls, telegrams, gas U& meals approved.

Bill of P. A. Cassady 5.00 as deputy marshall while H. Bishop was sick also approved.

H. Bishop was to be retained as a deputy marshall at present rate of salary \$25.00 per month for the time being, to be later determined by the board.

Street as heretofore planned, were ordered to be built on arrival of state highway department in said town.

J. E. Bohannon was empowered with authority to receive bids on priming oil & other oil necessary for the construction of College St., Broadway, Highland, Rumsey Ave., Stock St., First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth and Mill Sts totaling 10265 ft in said town, and to purchase same from the best bidder or bidders.

It was also ordered to borrow an amount of money necessary to construct said streets avboe the amount of cash on hand when said streets were completed.

There being no further business, meeting was adjourned until next regular meeting time
