
Minutes of the meeting of the Board. October 6, 1953.

The Board of Trustees met as usual in the Director's Room of the Deposit Bank, and after being called to order the following business was transacted:

1. Miss Elizabeth Vance appeared before the Board to explain her case. Miss Vance stated that she was willing to pay the 1951 and 1952 taxes but that was all because she had spent so much on improving the street by her house and that she had to spend quite a sum to prevent water from standing in her yard, etc. The Board refused to grant her request and she paid the four years which were charged to her (1949-1950-1951 and 1952). The Board did agree to check on the drainage system near her place and see what could be done.
2. The Clerk was instructed to write a letter to Mr. W. H. Meredith and thank him for keeping the park between the Fire Station and the L & N Depot clean throughout the summer months. It was to be for signature of Board members.
3. A discussion of the dead trees at the cemetery was entered into and it was decided that they would be cut. Also discussed the sale of lots, how much had been contributed to Cemetery fund, etc. The clerk reported a balance of \$844.91 in the Cemetery Fund and contributions for the Year totaling \$605.00 to date against \$814.00 for the Year 1952.
4. Also discussed the court situation and a total of 4 fines was reported collected during the month of September.

There being no further business to come before the Board the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting, the first Tuesday in November.
