

RESOLUTION 93-2

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE Warren COUNTY CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEMBERSHIP APPOINTMENTS TO THE BARREN RIVER PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL SERVING THE BARREN RIVER SERVICE DELIVERY AREA

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act, P.L. 97-300 requires the establishment of a Private Industry Council, for each Service Delivery Area, to provide policy guidance and exercise oversight of activities provided under the Act through the Area's Job Training Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Section 102 (d)(2) of the Act requires the Chief Elected Official of each unit of general local government, represented in the Service Delivery Area, to appoint private sector representatives to the Private Industry Council; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with recommendations from the U. S. Department of Labor and the Kentucky Department for Employment Services, the designated Chief Elected Officials may appoint a Chief Elected Official Designate for the purpose of administrative signature authority for the receipt of Job Training Partnership Act, P. L. 97-300, funds into the Service Delivery Area and for the appointment of Private Industry Council representation from the special categories designated in Section 102 (a)(2) and (a)(3); and,

WHEREAS, each County in the Barren River Service Delivery Area shall designate one Chief Elected Official,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY Smiths Grove City Commission, Smiths Grove, KENTUCKY, that the County Judge Executive of Warren County is hereby designated as the Chief Elected Official to represent the city of Smiths Grove for the purposes of carrying out the statutory mandates of the Job Training Partnership Act, P. L. 97-300, and to insure the expedient receipt of funds allocated to the Service Delivery Area through the Act, and it is further resolved by the Smiths Grove City Commission that the Smiths Grove City Commission reserves the right to change this designation on its own when it is deemed appropriate to the interests of the city of Smiths Grove.
